This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received an application to revise the charter(s) of the charter school(s) listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designees, the SUNY Charter Schools Committee or SUNY Charter Schools Institute (the "Institute"), anticipate consideration of this request as soon June 11, 2020. A description of the proposed action follows:

- **Capital Prep Charter Schools NY**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school, has requested the following revision:
  - **Capital Preparatory Harlem Charter School**, located at 1 East 104<sup>th</sup> Street, New York, New York 10029 in Community School District ("CSD") 4, currently authorized to serve 500 students in grades 6-10 for the 2019-20 school year and 600 students in grades 6-11 for the 2020-21 school year, the final year of the current charter term, has requested an enrollment decrease to serve 350 students in grade 6-10 for the 2019-20 school year and 400 students in grades 6-11 for the 2020-21 school year.
- **The International Charter School of New York**, located at 55 Willoughby Street, Brooklyn, NY 11201 in CSD 13 and 9 Hanover Place, Brooklyn, NY 11201 in CSD 15, chartered to serve 549 students in grades K-5 for the 2019-20, the final year of the current charter term, has requested an enrollment decrease to serve 431 students in grades K-5 for the 2019-20 school year.
