**SUBJECT: Third Notice of Charter Revision(s) – Operation of Law**

**DATE: November 9, 2018**

This third and final Notice, pursuant to New York Education Law § 2857(1), is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the “SUNY Trustees”), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, approved renewal(s) for the charter school(s) listed below, sent the renewal(s) to the New York State Board of Regents, and the renewal(s) have been approved by operation of law in accordance with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998 (as amended, the “Act”). As the Act requires no further action, this will be the last notice on these items. A description of the renewal(s) follows:

- **PUC Achieve Charter School**, located at 14 Mark Street, Rochester, NY in the Rochester City School District, currently authorized to serve approximately 406 students in grades 5-8, requested to separate from its charter management organization, PUC National, a California not-for-profit corporation, and change administrative and program elements, as necessary. The education corporation also requests to change the name of the Education Corporation and school to **ROC Achieve Charter School**. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about May 1, 2018; 2) approved the request on June 6, 2018; and, 3) the revision was approved by operation of law on September 26, 2018.
