This first Notice, pursuant to New York Education Law § 2857(1), is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received the following charter revision request(s):

- **Brooklyn Emerging Leader Academy Charter School**, located at 125 Stuyvesant Avenue, Brooklyn, New York, 11221 in Community School District ("CSD") 16, currently authorized to serve approximately 100 students in grade 9 for the 2017-18 school year and to grow to 371 students in grades 9-12 by the end of the current charter term, requests to decrease its enrollment to 85 students in grade 9 for the 2017-18 school year to grow to 314 students in grades 9-12 by the end of the current charter term.
- **Brooklyn Prospect Charter School**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school: **Brooklyn Prospect Charter School – CSD 13** located at 80 Willoughby Street, Brooklyn, New York in CSD 13 and **Brooklyn Prospect Charter School – CSD 15** located at 3002 Fort Hamilton parkway, Brooklyn, NY in CSD 15, has requested to enter into an agreement with charter management organization, Prospect Schools, Inc. to provide certain educational and operational services.
- **Cypress Hills Ascend Charter School (formerly Central Brooklyn Ascend Charter School 2)**, to be located at 396 Grant Avenue, Brooklyn, New York 11208 in CSD 19, currently authorized to serve approximately 224 students in grades K-1 for the 2018-19 school year requests an enrollment decrease to 166 students in grades K-1 for the 2018-19 school year growing to serve 498 students in grades K-5 by the 2022-23 school year, the last year of the current charter term.

- **East Harlem Scholars Academy Charter School**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school, has requested the following:
 - **East Harlem Scholars Academy Charter School**, located at 2050 Second Avenue, New York, New York 10029 in CSD 4, currently authorized to serve 496 students in grades K-8 requests to add a high school program beginning in the 2019-20 school year to serve an additional 125 students in grade 9 and growing to 500 students in grades 9-12 by the 2022-23 school year.
