**SUBJECT: Final Notice of Approval of Charter Revisions**

**DATE: April 24, 2015**

This final, updated Notice is to inform you that: 1) the State University of New York Board of Trustees, in its capacity as a charter authorizer, received proposed revisions of the charters of the schools listed below on September 16, 2013; 2) approved the revisions on May 27, 2014, and sent them to the New York State Board of Regents; and 3) the revisions were approved by operation of law in accordance with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998 (the "Act") on December 17, 2014. As the Act requires no further action, this will be the last notice regarding these items.

- **ROADS Charter School I**, located at 1495 Herkimer Street, Brooklyn, New York, 11233 in Community School District ("CSD") 23, which serves approximately 200 students in grades 9-11 during the 2014-15 school year; and,
- **ROADS Charter School II**, located at 1010 Rev. James A Polite Ave., Bronx, NY 10459 in CSD 12, which serves approximately 200 students in grades 9-10 during the 2014-15 school year; have been approved to enter into separate management agreements with ROADS Schools Inc., a New York not-for-profit, charter-management organization, to manage their educational programs. The schools also have been approved to defer enrollment growth for the third year of their charters only (2014-15 school year) from 250 students to 200 students in the same grade configuration to focus on the current cohorts to allow proficiency and credit attainment.
