SUBJECT: Notice of Receipt and Pending Action on Charter Revision Applications

This Notice is to inform you that the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer has received applications to revise the charters of the charter school listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designee, the SUNY Charter Schools Institute, anticipates consideration of this request as soon June 4, 2014.

Descriptions of the proposed actions follow:

- **ROADS Charter School I**, located at 1495 Herkimer Street, Brooklyn, New York, 11233 in Community School District ("CSD") 23, which will serve approximately 200 students in grades 9-11 during the 2014-15 school year; and
- **ROADS Charter School II**, located at 1010 Rev. James A Polite Ave., Bronx, NY 10459 in CSD 12, which will serve approximately 200 students in grades 9-10 during 2014-15 school year; propose to enter into separate management agreements with ROADS Schools Inc., a New York not-for-profit, charter-management organization, to manage their educational programs. The schools also propose to defer enrollment growth for the third year of their charters only (2014-15 SY) from 250 students to 200 students in the same grade configuration to focus on the current cohorts to allow proficiency and credit attainment.
