**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that pursuant to New York Education Law § 2857(1), the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, approved a revision of the charter to the school listed below, sent the revision to the New York State Board of Regents, and the revision has been approved by operation of law in accordance with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998 (as amended, the "Act"). As the Act requires no further action, this will be the last notice regarding this matter.

- **South Buffalo Charter School**, located at 154 South Ogden Street, Buffalo NY 14210, has been approved to delay a previously approved expansion in enrollment due to delays in facility project completion. The school will reduce its chartered enrollment from 850 students in grades K-8 in the 2012-13 school year to 669 students in the same grades, in 2013-14, and from 900 students in grades K-8 to 800 students in the same grades in 2014-15.
