- **Ark Community Charter School**, located at 762 River Street, Troy, NY 12180, seeks a five year renewal of its charter to commence on August 1, 2014. According to the renewal application, the school would continue to serve 210 students in grades K-6.
- **True North Troy Preparatory Charter School**, located at 2 Polk Street, Troy, NY 12180, seeks a five year renewal of its charter to commence on August 1, 2014. According to the renewal application, the school would grow to serve 515 students in grades K-8.
