This is in accordance with keeping students in the least restrictive environment appropriate to meeting their needs. Only after the school has determined that the interventions are not succeeding is a referral to special education made; once this process is started it can often take the external Committee for Special Education several months to complete the process of giving a student an IEP. Because of this process two

things occur. One, some students respond well to the internal interventions and are not ever referred to special education.
